Notes and Limitations

Permissions

- **(RN6691)** Some of the Settings pages require an additional permission in order to view the settings page. The following table includes the permissions that you need to add for each Settings page.

Browser Support

- **(RN5197)** EnterpriseView includes Activiti Modeler version 3.0.1. This version does not support Internet Explorer browsers.

Workaround: Open Activiti Modeler using a Chrome or Firefox browser using the following URL:

`http://<fully qualified domain name>:<EnterpriseView port>/activiti-modeler`

- **(RN6575)** You cannot import configuration data to EnterpriseView if you are using a client running on a Firefox browser.

Workaround: Open EnterpriseView from a Chrome or an IE browser.

Assets

- **(RN2545)** The information on some of the pages in EnterpriseView is not automatically refreshed. For example, if you make a change to an asset in the business model and you attempt to refresh this change in a different page.

Workaround: Click the browser refresh button to refresh the page.

Authentication

- **(RN6635)** EnterpriseView uses Activiti Modeler as a template editor (open the editor through **Task Management > Manage Templates > Template Editor**). Activiti Modeler does not require authentication and is accessible to everyone.

Workaround: You can use any authentication method to implement authentication for accessing Activiti Modeler. Open Activiti Modeler using the following URL:

`http://<fully qualified domain name>:<EnterpriseView port>/activiti-modeler`

Dashboards and Reports

- **(RN6150)** The Risk Score Details report displays the adjusted probability even when there are no control to threat mappings. In this case, the adjusted probability displays the same score as the treated probability.
- **(RN6761)** The information displayed in a dashboard component is limited to the size of the component in the UI and the screen size. In cases when the information exceeds the component size, then the information displayed is partial.

Job Management

- **(RN2218)** You cannot run jobs that import information from ArcSight ESM in parallel. These jobs include the asset synchronization job, the threat import job, and the jobs that are created for importing external risk factor information from ArcSight ESM. Running the jobs in parallel will cause them to fail.

Workaround: When you schedule the jobs in the Configuration module, make sure that the jobs are scheduled at least 30 minutes apart.

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
